THE NORTHERN IRELAND ASSEMBLY

The Northern Ireland Assembly is based in Parliament Buildings at Stormont in Belfast. The Assembly has the power to make decisions and pass laws about the following issues that affect Northern Ireland:

- agriculture;
- ancient monuments and historical buildings;
- culture;
- economic development;
- education and training; and
- environment;
- health and health services;
- housing;
- industry;
- local government;
- social services.
- sport and leisure;
- tourism;
- town and country planning;
- transport and roads;
- water and flood defence;

These issues are called transferred matters. Issues such as policing and criminal law are called reserved matters and the Assembly has to get permission from the UK Government to make decisions about these issues. Issues that are important to the UK as a whole such as defence and foreign policy are excepted matters. This means that they are the responsibility of the UK Parliament.

THE NORTHERN IRELAND EXECUTIVE

The Assembly gives executive power to an Executive Committee which makes many of the Assembly's day-to-day decisions. This committee is made up of the First Minister and deputy First Minister along with a minister for each of the 10 government departments. Two Junior Ministers assist the First and deputy First Ministers. Ministers are appointed to each of these positions using a system called the d'Hondt formula. The formula works out ministerial seats based on the number of MLAs a political party has in the Assembly.

The Executive Committee meets to discuss and agree on issues which cut across the responsibilities of two or more Ministers.

STATUTORY COMMITTEES

The Assembly has 17 Committees (11 statutory and 6 non-statutory). Each statutory committee has a Chair and a Deputy Chair allocated using the proportional d'Hondt System. Membership of Committees is in broad proportion to parties' electoral mandates in the Assembly ensuring that the opportunity of Committee places was available to all Members.

Each Committee has a scrutiny, policy development and consultation role in relation to its Department and a role in the initiation of legislation. They have the power to:

- Consider and advise on Departmental budgets and annual plans within the overall budget allocation;
- Approve relevant secondary legislation and undertake the Committee stage of relevant primary legislation;
- Call for persons and papers to advise and assist Northern Ireland Ministers in forming policy;
- Initiate enquiries and make reports;
- Consider and advise on matters referred to the Committee by its Minister.

Northern Ireland Assembly Members 2009

Northern Ireland is divided into 18 constituencies for the purposes of election to the Assembly - the same as those used for election of MPs to Westminster. Each constituency elects six representatives on a system of proportional representation. This differs from Westminster elections where each constituency sends a single member (MP) who is elected on a first past the post basis.
